KARTS Update

Local County Match

KARTS relies on different entities to help us provide transportation service to the citizens of the counties we serve: Vance, Granville, Franklin and Warren. Contributing to the local match portion of our funding needs ensures we can go the extra mile and afford our passengers safe and reliable service.

The local match is dependent on annual grant fund availability by FTA and the State of North Carolina. The match portion ranges from 10% to 50% depending on the type of funds and availability of State match funds.

In the past grants for Administrative costs have been 80% federal, 5% state match, and 15% local match. Capital costs have been funded 80% federal, 10% state match, and 10% local match; Operating grants are funded 50% state funds and 50% local match. Operating grants depend heavily on the Rural Operating Assistance Program (ROAP) funded by North Carolina to cover the local portion needed.

KARTS FY25 Budget has been approved at \$5,754,966 including Administrative, Operational and Capital.

Of which \$75,759 or 1.3% per county will be contributed to the Administrative and Capital grant match.

Rural Operating Assistance Program

Each county is allocated these funds directly from the state yearly.

- RGP Rural General Public
- EMPL Employment
- EdTap Elderly and Disabled

RGP funds are suballocated to KARTS, while EMPL and EdTap funds are not.

If these funds are not reported to be used by the end of July for the preceding year the amount not utilized will be subtracted from the next years allotment.

NCDOT/IMD has assigned the reporting responsibility to KARTS. It continues to be an effort to receive these figures from each county in a timely manner.

For FY 26 we will be requesting that KARTS become the direct recipients of these funds. KARTS can track their usage through our database and submit reports on time and assuring all available funds are utilized.

If any of the counties has a need, they can communicate that to KARTS, and we will provide the transportation and will have that recorded to report to the state.

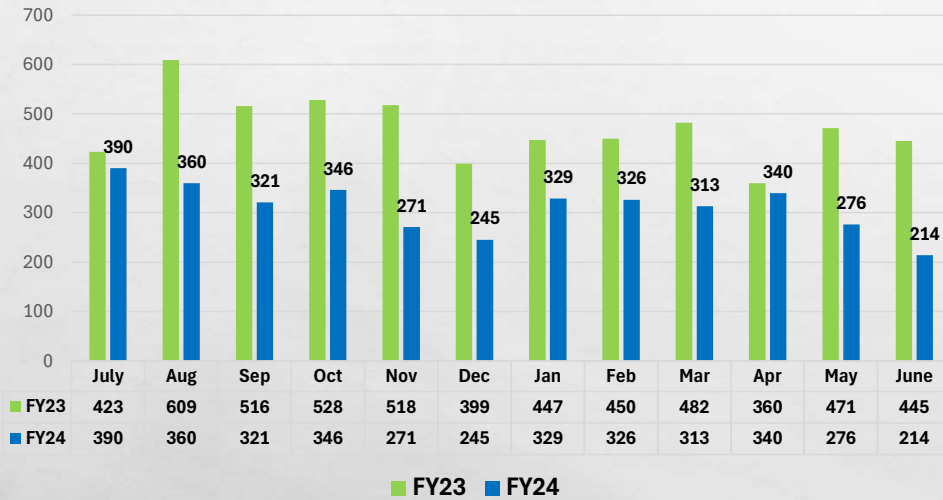

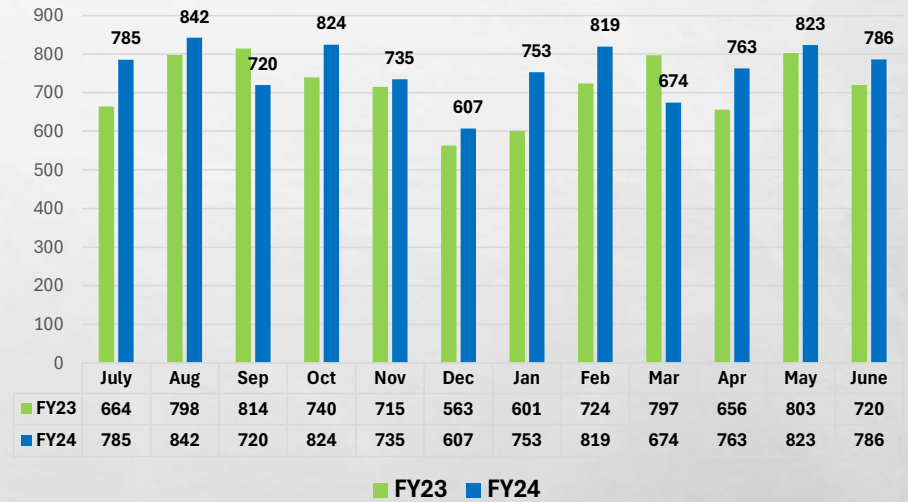
Overall Ridership for FY24 143,596

SYSTEM CHANGES

- We've eliminated over \$250,000 of recurring annual costs in technology and other nonessential wants.
- We've combined vacant positions and reassigned those duties to existing staff.
- Trip Scheduling and routing has improved and is expected to continue in that direction with new updated scheduling software.
- New software costs will be absorbed by the MEE Grant over the next three years.
- Eventual elimination of Saturday service and controls in place for new service requests to align with our service hours.
- With fleet replacement we expect savings in repair costs.
- Service equipment added to our garage will eliminate external repairs.

CURRENT CHALLENGES

- Staffing both hiring and retention
- Scheduling efficiently due to rural component
- Fluctuating Fuel and Maintenance Costs
- Rising Insurance Costs
- Training requirements mandated by the government
- Lack of available trips being offered by Medicaid transportation brokers
- Difficulties with replacing aging fleet in a timely manner

Staff Report

Phase 1B Water Tower Update. In April 2024 the work on Phase 1B, Contract 2 (Elevated Tank) project began. The project started with electrical work being done at the valves at US 1. This included new electrical control box and meter box for Duke Energy. Next the old saddle valve was replaced with new saddle valve with electronic pressure reducing valves on it. This controls the water coming from the City of Henderson going to the elevated tank and citizens in Kittrell. Next, the reconditioning of the elevated tank and site began. Work began by removing existing 50' x 50' area of fencing around the tank, then a large oak tree was removed to allow a larger fenced in area. Wake Electric installed a temporary pole and installed a new antenna for their readings. Water was drained from the tank itself and the new saddle valve and valve on N. Chavis road were opened to maintain an allowable amount of pressure to supply the citizens of Kittrell. Welding began on the tank, including new interior ladder, removing of spider rods and new roof vent. Commissioner The tank was sandblasted inside and out at this point. Several areas were then welded where holes were from sandblasting. The overflow pipe was replaced inside the tank connecting to existing line in the ground. The tank was then primed and painted, and logo was installed. A new Missions SCADA system was installed. The tank was then treated on the inside, filled with water, drained and refilled. A new 100' x 100' fence was installed, and area was graded, gravel driveway installed, and grass was sewn. Vance County staff along with Envirolink staff were included on a training with LKC and Charles Underwood on how to operate the saddle valve and SCADA system. The tank was put back online October 1, 2024. *For your information.*

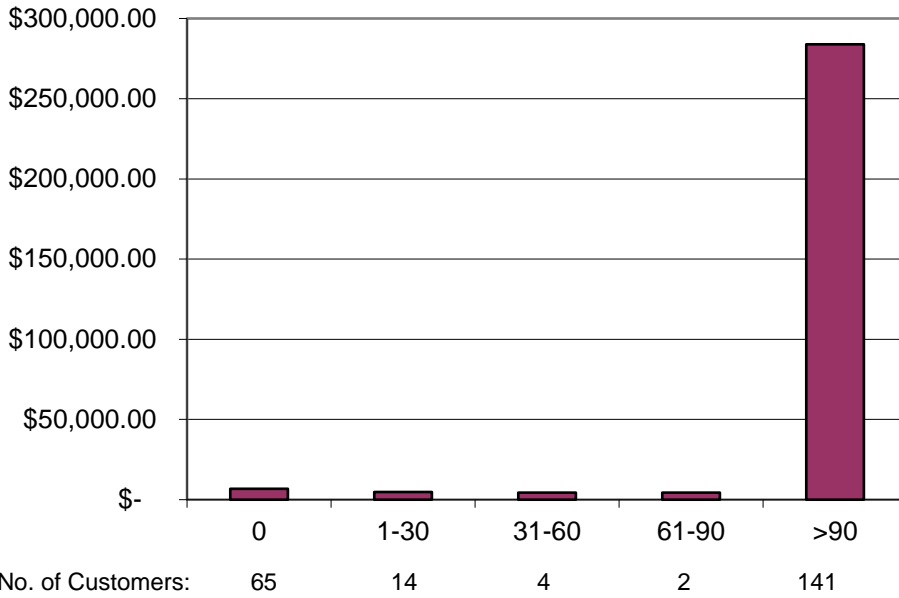

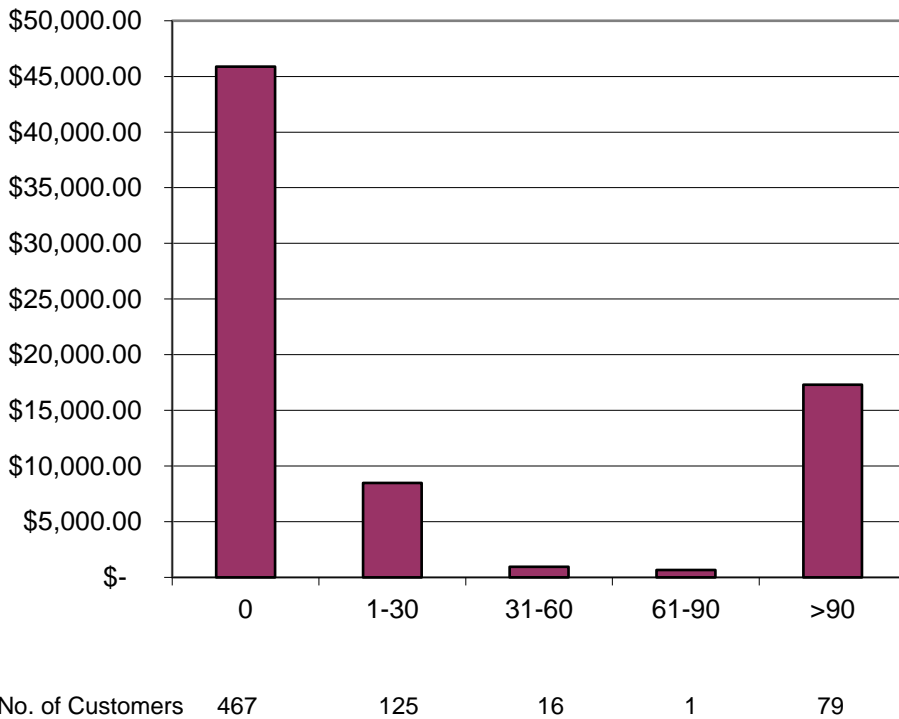

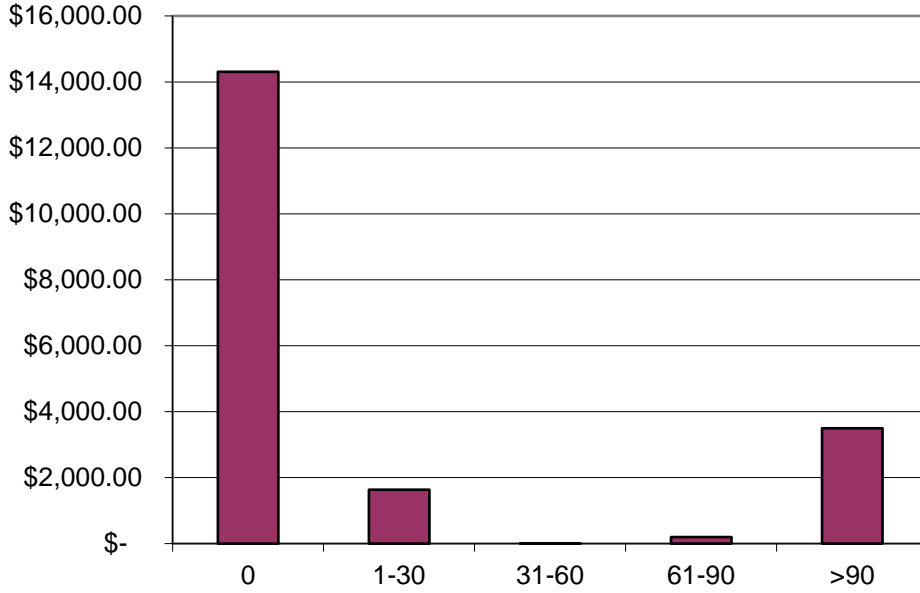

The attached financial report captures this information and below is a summarization of the report.

- **Revenues**

- Revenue that has been collected and posted for this period is \$5,204,417.98 which represents 8.53% of the Amended Budgeted Revenue.
- In comparison with the same time frame as last fiscal year, we collected \$10,176,643.93, which was approximately 17% of the Amended Budgeted Revenue.

***NOTE:** For the month of September 2024, \$4,561,135 was deposited into the Tax Bank Account. After the completion of their monthly reconciliation process, the Tax Office will send documents to Finance for the transfer and posting of these funds into the General Bank Account. This will bring the revenue collected for this period to approximately \$9.7 million and will result in the collection increase of the Amended Revenue from 8.53% to 15.9%.*

- **Expenses**

- The expenditures spent for this period is \$13,194,741.71, represent 21.63% of the Amended Budgeted Expenditure.
- In comparison with the same time frame as last year, we spent \$11,831,796.70 which was 20% of last fiscal year's budget.

County of Vance Audit Committee Meeting Summarization

The Audit Committee met on Thursday, September 19, 2024 at 4:00pm. Committee members present were Chairman Brummitt, Commissioner Hester, Amanda Spivey and Mark Woodlief. Staff present were C. Renee Perry, County Manager and Stephanie Williams, Budget & Finance Director.

County Manager Perry stated that the staff is revamping the Financial Policies, that were last adopted July 11, 2016 and they will be ready for presentation to the BoCC by July 2025.

Although the Fund Balance is a factor that can be used to determine a unit's fiscal health, there is no state statute nor LGC Policy that requires local governments to maintain an 8% nor any specific level of fund balance available.

At the conclusion of the FY 22-23 external audit, we had an excess of \$21 million in the General Fund Balance. The external audit for FY 23-24, is underway and the new fund balance will be updated after it is completed.

Commissioner Hester asked how often the external auditors come for a visit and do they review current FY transactions. Finance Director stated that the auditors review data for the fiscal year that has ended. The review of current data is not within the scope of the contract we currently have, and it would require a discussion with them. The idea of staff conducting an internal audit was discussed and the Finance Director expressed that we don't have the staffing level to complete those tasks. As requested, the County Manager has inquired of her fellow county managers if their municipality has an internal audit department. If this is something the BoCC wants to do, then we will explore with the next fiscal year during the budget work sessions.

Chairman Brummitt wants county staff to work on an RFP to have a forensic audit conducted of prior years' financial records. Staff will explore the options and report back to the committee, however we do not recommend a forensic audit be conducted because the return on the investment is zero. There are no additional options for insurance with the NCACC due to the previous FD being bonded. We are focused on establishing financial policies, procedures and putting internal controls in place to deter and prevent future fraud and misappropriations.

There were also some items from the FY23 audit that Chairman Brummitt wants clarification on. FD is obtaining clarification on those items.

County Manager's Report to the Board

- A. Fire Prevention Week Proclamation.** Fire Prevention Week is a nationally observed week in the United States from the Sunday to Saturday in which October 9 falls and is a way to keep the public informed of the importance of fire prevention. *Recommendation: Approve the proclamation recognizing October 6-12, 2024 as Fire Prevention Week in Vance County.*
- B. Breast Cancer Awareness Month Proclamation.** Breast Cancer Awareness Month is an international health campaign that is held every October. The month aims to promote screening and prevention of the disease, which affects 2.3 million women worldwide. Known best for its pink theme color, the month features a number of campaigns and programs conducted by groups ranging from breast cancer advocacy organizations to local community organizations. *Recommendation: Approve proclamation in support of Breast Cancer Awareness Month.*
- C. Operation Green Light Resolution.** Operation Green Light is an initiative endorsed by the NC Association of County Commissioners (NCACC) and the National Association of Counties (NACo) and the National Association of County Veteran Service Officers (NACVSO) that shows support and honor for military veterans. During Operation Green Light residents and businesses are asked to shine a green light or light their buildings green from November 7 to November 13 as a way of letting veterans know they are seen, appreciated, and supported. The enclosed resolution supports this effort which will include lighting the exterior lights at the Henry Dennis Building and other county buildings as able. *Recommendation: Approve resolution supporting operation green light for veterans.*
- D. Justice Assistance Grant.** The Vance County Sheriff's Office and the Henderson Police Department jointly receive federal funds from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG) to purchase equipment. The City submits the application and conducts the required due diligence. The distribution of funds is 70% City (\$30,769) and 30% County (\$10,756). The two governing bodies must enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (Inter-local Agreement) in order to receive and utilize the federal funds. Due to the timeframe for the grant, both city and county managers have authorized submittal of the grant with receipt subject to final action by the Board. *Recommendation: Approve the inter-local agreement between the City and County for the purpose of receiving and using federal JAG funds in the amount of \$10,756.*
- E. Records Preservation – Register of Deeds.** The Register of Deeds is completing additional preservation of birth record books similar to work completed over the past three years. The next group to be preserved are birth records from 1913, 1932, 1934, and 1940. North Carolina law requires approval from the board to remove records for greater than 24 hours. The records will be taken to Greensboro for approximately 18-22 weeks to complete the preservation process and the cost will be covered out of the Register of Deeds automation fund. *Recommendation: Approve resolution authorizing documents to be taken offsite from the Register of Deeds Office for the purpose of preservation.*

- F. Employee Appreciation Day.** With board approval, I am requesting to close county offices from 4pm to 5pm on Friday, October 11, 2024. Employees will enjoy food, games, line dancing, and more at Aycock Recreation Center. Please join us if you can. *Recommendation: Approve the Manager's recommendation to close county offices from 4pm – 5pm on October 11, 2024.*
- G. Our State, Our Homes: Partnering to Address Housing Needs in North Carolina.** The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill's Carolina Across 100 initiative, with support from the UNC School of Government's Development Finance Initiative and other campus partners, announced its fifth program. Over the course of this 18-month program, Carolina Across 100 will bring together entities from across campus to facilitate cross-sector collaboration among selected community teams comprised of a diverse set of stakeholders including local government agencies, housing developers, builders, financial institutions, supportive service providers, employers, faith-based and community organizations and more. Communities that wish to apply for the program must submit an online application. The application deadline is November 22, 2024. *Recommendation: Approve or deny submittal of an application for this 18 month program.*
- H. Annual Planning Retreat.** The Board of Commissioners' annual planning retreat will be held on January 31, 2025. Time and location will be announced later. *For your information.*

SECTION 3: Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any Liability for claims against COUNTY other than claims for which the Tort Laws of the State of North Carolina may impose liability.

SECTION 4: Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against CITY other than claims for which the Tort Laws of the State of North Carolina may impose liability.

SECTION 5: Each party to the agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this agreement and shall not be liable for any city liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

SECTION 6: The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this Agreement.

SECTION 7: By entering into this Agreement, the parties do not intent to create any obligations express or implied other than those set out herein, further, this Agreement shall not create any rights in any party not a signatory hereto.



Cooperative Extension – September 2024

Corporate Extension Director/Family and Consumer Science

On Tuesday, September 17th we hosted the Advisory Leadership Council meeting at 8:30 a.m. ALC members are expected to learn the core program areas of NC Cooperative Extension, help identify the needs of the community and meet quarterly to provide input to the Vance County Extension Director that helps shape development and delivery of Extension programs. We believe our ALC members are some of our greatest cheerleaders, ready to communicate Extension's impact to decision makers and citizens alike. If you have expertise, experience, or ideas that you believe can make a difference, please reach out to us to learn more about how we can work together to improve the lives of Vance County residents.

Vance County Cooperative Extension had a staff retreat on Tuesday, September 24th. A strategic planning meeting is a critical step in setting goals and a direction for our team. We didn't talk about day-to-day tasks or any operational issues. Staff finalized their 2030 vision: "We are a trusted and well-known source of education and research-based information that helps build a brighter future for a healthier Vance County." We developed a strategic plan focusing on goals in the areas of programs, partnerships, and marketing. We are excited to continue serving Vance County residents in the areas of Agriculture, Food & Nutrition, Youth Development, and Parenting.

Agriculture/Horticulture/Small Farms/Farmers Market

Don't let the changing seasons fool you, farmers have been hard at work as they head into their "off" season. Over the past month, several found their way to Extension hosted events to stay up to date on the latest pesticide safety practices which helps keep their applicator licenses in good standing. Commercial applicators, like lawn care professionals, weren't left out as Extension also offered a multi-credit course in conjunction with Warren, Granville, and Person Counties.

Hot on the heels of pesticide education courses was a special pesticide disposal event at the Vance County Regional Farmers Market led by NCDA&CS. Crews worked for several hours educating residents and ensuring safe disposal of over 1100 lbs of chemicals that could have otherwise been environmentally devastating. The disposal was so successful that Extension has already begun making plans for the next event.

However, the education hasn't been purely outward facing. Ag agents joined together in Person County for a district meeting to discuss pressing issues concerning the region's agriculture. After the meeting, they met personally with the owners of J&B Herb Farm in Roxboro where they heard about the challenges facing a rapidly changing industry and how J&B is adapting to meet the needs of customers.

Even with such a busy schedule, agents were still able to find time to play in the dirt. The Boys & Girls Club on Clarke St. has a particularly nice crop of collards, broccoli, and kale coming in thanks to the hard work of the organization's Garden Club. In fact, agents have met with several schools and community-facing organizations to help them plan their own gardens for debut next spring.

Pat Ayscue, Vance County Regional Farmers Market Manager and Wykia Macon, County Extension Director, presented to the Rotary Club on September 10th. After sharing success stories of current programs, the two discussed the market's vision for the future and expressed gratitude for the continued interest and support from Commissioner Hester, the Rotary Club and its members.

Vance Warren Beekeepers met on September 9th for their monthly meeting with 19 members in attendance. John Short presented on combining colonies and preparing for winter. Mite control was the program. There was discussion about completing populating of their apiary in memory of Don Faulkner so they can have their grand opening this fall. Discussion was also made on whether to purchase an Owl with the Granville County Association. An Owl will greatly improve their online streaming and recording. There was also discussion for final preparations about the upcoming Honey Extraction Day on September 15th.

One of the best things about keeping bees is harvesting their honey! Extracting, or harvesting, honey is a well-known benefit of beekeeping. On September 15th, the Vance Warren & Granville Beekeepers teamed with Vance Cooperative Extension to conduct their second honey extraction day of 2024 at the Vance County Regional Farmers Market. They all helped each other out and a fun time was had extracting wonderful, sweet honey! A total of nine beekeepers extracted honey and 15 people attended the event. If anyone is interested in beekeeping, the best resource for learning is from a local bee keeping club or association. They are helpful and full of advice and opinions.

Fall Vegetable Garden...what better way to kick off your fall vegetable dreams with tips and tricks for a fall season vegetable garden? On September 30th at 6:30 p.m. Wayne Rowland presented learning objectives on what to grow in the cooler season, when you should start your planting, where you should plant your garden and how to prepare the soils for growing all the leafy greens and crunchy root veggies. Participants were able to ask questions and connect with other gardening enthusiasts.

If you'd rather just buy fresh vegetables instead of growing them, there's a farmer waiting to meet you at the Vance County Regional Farmers Market! Be sure to bring your little ones, ages 0-5 for a special Story Time at the Market on October 26th starting at 9am thanks to help from Perry Memorial Library.

09/05/24- For recipients of veterans benefits payouts and Social Security benefits, the cost-of-living adjustment could be less than 3% in 2025. If so, this would be the lowest mark since before the pandemic, according to the Senior Citizens League, an independent watchdog group. Officials from the group recently announced their latest projection for Social Security COLA rates for the upcoming year, estimating the figure will be less than 2.6%.

09/09/24- The VA recently announced plans to start transitioning veterans over the coming year to a more streamlined and what will hopefully be a more modern login process to access benefit and healthcare services.

This step comes as the VA has been working on new strategies to safeguard veteran data and that of their beneficiaries.
